PURPOSE: A VOTE TO ACCEPT PASTOR CHRISTINA KADELBACH AS OUR NEW CANDIDATE OF CHOICE FOR PASTOR WHEN: SUNDAY, APRIL 13, 2025 @ 10:00 AM

BACKGROUND:

- On Friday, April 11th we had a Potluck Meet & Greet with Pastor Christina Kadelbach and her family.
- On Sunday, April 13th we voted on whether to accept or decline her candidacy as our new pastor and accept or decline the additional Compensation & Benefits costs.

ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL DATA:

• There will be a 15% increase in our annual budgeted Pastor salary/benefits amount due to health coverage for her spouse. (Which, if Pastor James would have stayed, we most likely would have had to cover his new spouse).

THE VOTE:

- Governed by the bylaws of our constitution, members of the church must vote in person and it will be a simple majority vote. The vote requires 10% of our members present to vote in order to fulfill a quorum and a 51% majority vote will determine the outcome.
- We had 61 voting members present, and the vote was 60 votes of YES to accept Christina Kadelbach as our new Pastor and 1 Undecided vote. We had 60 votes to accept the Compensation & Benefits costs and 1 Undecided vote.

- 2. Forward the information to the NEMN Synod
- Installation scheduled for June 1, 2025, 9:00am during Sunday worship at Bethesda Lutheran Church of Malmo


